

Congratulations!

With distyNotruf you have purchased a DECT/GAP - Telephone that you use by simply pressing a button.

distyNotruf is the direct connection to your confidants.

You decide with whom you speak directly in an emergency situation.

Up to 5 telephone numbers can be stored.

First, the **distyNotruf**has to be subscribed with your DECT -phone (see page 6).

distyNotruf dials automatically the first of the programmed phone numbers after pressing the alarm button for 1 second. Then you can speak directly. The called party confirms the call by sending a "#" key from his phone.

If this is not done, because the recipient is not available, busy or an answering machine is taking the call, then **distyNotruf** dials automatically the next stored number. This procedure will continue as long until the emergency call is picked up by a person and is confirmed.



distyNotruf as a telephone with hands-free function

You can also use **distyNotruf** as a telephone.

All incoming calls can be picked up with one button. So you are always accessible, from any place in Your home. Even in the garden or cellar you can use **distyNotruf**¹. * **distyNotruf** is protected against water spray and can also be used in the shower. Therefor the protection lid on the **distyNotruf** must be closed!

Easy storage of phone numbers

We will take care of configuring your emergency numbers free of charge. Further information see page 7.

With a belt clip you can wear the distyNotruf always at your body.

In case of malaise/ anxiety health problems, attack, falling to the floor, etc., you can immediately communicate by pressing the alarm button.

Commissioning

Charging

The battery of your **distyNotruf** must be fully charged before use (at least 4 hours).

First pull off the sealing lid from the **distyNotruf** and plug in the jack of the cable. Connect the other side of the charging with the power supply and plug it to a wall socket.

distyNotruf is fully charged when the red LED has stopped blinking. Replace the protection lid on the **disty**Notruf after disconnecting the cable. This prevents to come dust/dirt/humidity into the plug, which might damage the device on the long run!

Subscription

Before you can make calls with **distyNotruf**, the device must be paired with the base station of your DECT telephone. This procedure is called subscription.

For this purpose the subscription of your normal DECT telephone activated via the Paging-

Button (see user manual of the DECT telephone). Connect the **disty**Notruf with the charging cable, as described in the chapter above.

Now press and hold the button (10 sec.), until the green LED lights up. Release button within 5 seconds. Now you see the green LED flashing. The **distyNotruf** is looking for a DECT - base station with subscription activated.





A high signal tone sounds from the **distyNotruf** after successful registration.

The enrollment process is complete.

Store phone numbers

Three methods are available for programming:


1. "First incoming call", 2. via the service telephone/our Hot-line, 3. self-programming.

"First incoming call" (store an emergency number) (charging cable not plugged)

Ask the person (for example, a relative, a neighbor), whom you want to reach at your fingertips

to make a call to your just subscribed **distyNotruf**. Thereby the phone number of the caller (CLIP = *Calling Line Identification Presentation*) is stored as the 1st. emergency number. You will recognize the successful saving of the emergency number because the **distyNotruf** releases the connection immediately after answering the call.

In case you do not want to outperform this procedure, you should leave the **distyNotruf** connected to the charging cable. This prevents unwanted storage of an emergency number.





Via the service Hot-Line (store several emergency numbers)

We will gladly program for you free of charge up to five emergency numbers and parameters.

- 1. Write down the desired phone numbers incl. prefixes, best on the rear of these operating instructions.
- 2. Press the emergency call button. If your **distyNotruf** is subscribed, it calls our service telephone automatically².
- 3. Tell us the recorded numbers one after the other.
- 4. After that, we program your desired settings. **Important**: The telephone connection must not be interrupted!
- 5. Ready

Self-programming

This is done by calling the **distyNotruf** e.g. from your mobile phone/cell phone and establish a connection.

To avoid malfunction, caused by of audio feedback, the **distyNotruf** should not be in the same room as the calling device!

Dial the code & numbers as outlined on the last page of this operating manual. Repeat this procedure for each emergency number.

distyNotruf is now ready for operation!

For safety reasons you should check the entered numbers: Press the emergency call button. Your **distyNotruf** now dials all the stored numbers in subsequent order. If you are unclear, call us at the Hot-Line with your normal telephone.

Functionality

Making a direct call



Press the alarm button for at least 1 second. **distyNotruf** dials the first of the stored phone numbers. The red LED blinks and indicates that the establishment of the connection has started.

Chain of alarm calls/Alarm acknowledgment

The call must be acknowledged/confirmed by pressing the "#" key on her/his telephone. The called party is prompted by a voice message for confirmation. If the emergency call is not confirmed by the called person within 20 seconds³, **distyNotruf** releases this call and automatically selects the second telephone number and, in the case of non-acceptance, the next stored telephone number. This will be repeated until a personal voice connection has been established to one of your trusted persons.

Cancel a Direct Call/ Alarm

If you accidentally triggered an alarm, simply press the alarm button again for 1 second.

Note:

'#' (= hash) In order to acknowledge your alarm call, the recipients of your call must enter this key (This prevents that the alarm is taken by an answering machine or mailbox). Please tell your call partners!

Take calls

All incoming calls can be picked comfortably via the button. An incoming call is signaled at the **distyNotruf** by the green flashing LED and by beep sounds.

Range warning


The **distyNotruf** will give a warning tone, if you are at the limit of the coverage area of your DECT phone.

Volume


The volume of the loudspeaker can be adjusted. To do this, call the our service Hot-Line.

Troubleshooting

If I press the alarm button to trigger an alarm, nothing happens.

- Check whether the red LED blinks with a cycle of one second. Then your **distyNotruf** is not in the coverage area of your DECT phone. Note that you must be within the range of the base station/ max. Range: 50 m.
- Check whether **distyNotruf** is sufficiently charged. I can make an alarm call, but do not get a voice connection.



- **Note** that **distyNotruf** is located in the reception area of the base station (up to 50 m in the building and up to 300 m outdoors).
- Whether **distyNotruf** is sufficiently charged.
- May be, that there is currently a telephone network fault. If you do not get a connection with your normal telephone, then there is fault in the telephone network present.



Mode Charging	Indication to user (Light/Sound)
Just connecting with the charging cable	Signal tone, red LED lights up once
Connected with the charging cable	Red LED flashes during the charging process and goes off when the charging is completed (flashing once per second)





Mode	Indication to user (Light/Sound)	
Low battery	Red LED flashes every 30 seconds, signal beeps	
Subscribed & registered/ Stand-by mode	Green LED flashes once every 10 seconds	
Subscribed, outside of DECT -coverage area	Red LED blinks with once second cycle	
DECT connection	Green LED lit	
Alarm/ button pressed	Red LED flashing fast	
Incoming call	Green LED flashing, Signal tone once	
Range warning	Red LED flashes fast, Signal tone	



How to wear the distyNotruf

The **distyNotruf** can be worn on the body in three different ways:



Option 1: Attaching the distyNotruf to the wrist.

The bracelet is already pre-assembled on the factory side. The **distyNotruf** must be placed on the arm in such a way that the charging socket/protection lid points towards the body. The shorter end of the bracelet should be pulled through the opening of the other half of the bracelet and tightened according to the arm thickness. The two pins of the closure piece must be firmly pressed

into the opposite holes.

For a disassembly of the wrist band, one presses the spring pin from the outside of the bore with a needle or an office clip so that it can be compressed and removed from the bore. The pre-assembled bracelet can be replaced by a standard 22 mm watchstrap.










Option 2: Attach the clip to the belt.

Removing the spring clip (see paragraph for option 1) Remove the spring pins from the bracelet and insert a spring pin on the side of the charging jack. Press the inner part of the clip down to the bottom of the clip and slide this tounge under the

mounted spring pin. Next, insert the spring pin into the clip. Move the clip into the

approximate end position while inserting one side of the spring pin into the hole provided for this purpose. Press the second side of the spring pin towards the clip while holding the clip and press it into the final position.





Option 3: Fasten with the collar/Lanyard.

Firstly mount the belt clip as described above. Insert the neckband under the outer flap.

Reset to factory settings

The settings you have made can be reset to the delivery condition. The programmed emergency numbers are retained. To do this, please follow the steps below (**distyNotruf** must be subscribed):

- connect the distyNotruf to the charging cable, the red LED will light up
- immediately after putting **distyNotruf** into charging mode, press & hold the alarm button for 10 seconds
- the green LED goes on
- release the alarm button before the LED goes out (5 sec. Time)
- a 450 Hz tone is heard and the red LED goes on & off after a while
- disconnect **distyNotruf** from the charging cable
- distyNotruf goes into "Power down" mode and switches off
- now it is un subscribed and configured to the factory settings.



Safety information

Please take note of the following safety instructions and check the contents of the packaging before using it for the first time.

- 1. **disty**Notruf is intended for communication in a DECT installation.
- 2. Please keep this manual in a safe place.
- 3. Clean only with a damp cloth.
- 4. Do not use the device in extreme environmental conditions.
- 5. **distyNotruf** is protected against splashing water and can be used in the shower. Do not immerse in water.
- 6. Never hold the device directly to the ear! The sound pressure of the loudspeaker could affect your hearing.
- 7. Use only the supplied power supply & cable for charging. Replace the protection lid on the **distyNotruf** after disconnecting the cable.
- 8. The device is operated with a lithium-ion battery. Charge your **distyNotruf** regularly and completely.
- 9. Do not attempt to disassemble or repair the unit. All maintenance and repair work must be carried out by well trained and qualified personnel.
- 10. Caution Risk of explosion if the battery is not replaced correctly. Disposal of used batteries according to instructions.
